The Genealogical Computing Group (**GCG**) is an Interest Group of the **New Zealand Society of Genealogists (NZSG)** and has several hundred subscribers throughout New Zealand.

Our three key objectives are to:

- foster and encourage the use of computers as a tool for genealogical research
- provide subscribers with information and advice on the use of computers and their programs (which assist genealogical research)
- assist computer projects related to the storage, retrieval and indexing of genealogical information

The GCG has a national committee elected at Annual General Meetings, responsible for :

- maintaining the GenCom News subscriber database
- sponsoring and supporting the establishment of “**subgroups**”
- publishing a quarterly magazine - **GenCom News** - dispatched in March, June, September, and December
- liaising with our parent body: the **New Zealand Society of Genealogists**
- maintaining our web site
