GCG AGM - 15 June 2024

Our Annual General Meeting of the Genealogical Computing Group was held on Saturday, 15 July 2023 at the NZSG FRC Meeting Room at 1:30 pm.

Since then, the GCG has been busy conducting our open meetings and the Expo.

The following GCG public open meetings were held in 2023 and 2024.

- August No meeting, as this was the 2023 Auckland Family History Expo. Once again this was an excellent weekend. Our members did a very good job.
- September Lorraine Rice spoke on Maori Research at the FRC including looking at some associated websites.
- October Dorothy Walker spoke on "Simple Enhancing & repairing of old Photos".
- November We held a "Christmas Special" free research all day at the FRC with a Christmas lunch provided. GCG paid for the use of the Library for each of our members. The committee was disappointed that the turnout was lower than we had hoped for.
- February '24 We had a Q&A session where members & visitors put forward questions. We also had a discussion and demonstration of using Gedcom file transfer on Legacy followed by an introduction to a new website for NZ, searching called 'NZ Ancestor Search Helper'.  Luke demonstrated his NZ Ancestor Search Helper (ASH).
